





TODAY'S MEETING

The last race meeting in Scotland for this season blasts off at 1.45 with the highly competitive Road Sports Car race in which late entries have been received from 121 C. Elstrop, 122 R. Sarafilovic and 137 W. Leitch to bring the grid up to 11 cars.

The Town & Country Car Rentals sponsored GT Championship is not yet settled with Kenny Coleman only 5 points in front of Ron Cumming who was hospitalised earlier in the season for major surgery. Ron is still sorting out his newly-acquired AC3000 but will still be looking for maximum points in the Championship. Kenny is running in the up to 1000 cc class so, since points are scored on a class basis, could also score maximum points thereby securing the Championship.

The two FF1600 Championships sponsored by MacAndrews for Citroën in the Senior division and by Tom Brown Racing School for the Juniors who have no more than 2 years experience in this type of car. The results today in both Championships will also remain provisional until the results of post-race engine checks requested earlier in the season are known. The two contenders in the Senior Championship are Cameron Binnie and



Colin Harper with only 3 points between them. The points scoring for the FF1600 Championship mean that Colin will have to be 4 places in front of Cameron to overtake him. The Junior Championship is even closer with only one point between newcomer Louis Di Resta and David Taylor.

The Road saloon race will be run in two classes or, if there are over 20 available competitors, then in two races and at the moment we have late entries from 157 J. MacIntyre in the over 1600 class and 156 Cameron MacPhail, 174 Geoff Williams and 176 Ed McNeilage in the smaller class.

The Lowland Tyres & Exhausts Sports Car Championship may have been won by Andy Smith already but this has not put off the others in this race which sees a 13-car grid and includes three very different sports cars — Lawrence Jacobsen's Chevron B16 returning to the circuit again, Andrew Fletcher with for the first time at Ingliston the 1973 Alfa Romeo T33 and Jim McGaughay returning with his Tiga thundersport car.

Historic cars have become a part of the Scottish scene again over the last two years thanks to John Foster and sponsors like John Romanes of Lothian Chemical Co. The race today moves from our usual handicap format to a straight 2-class (pre- and post-WW2) race with the Doune Cup for the first pre-war car. 21 Grant Stephen with his Elva and 15 George Cooper in the 1933 MG J2 are added to the entry list.




Road Sports Cars have proved a popular class in 1988.




