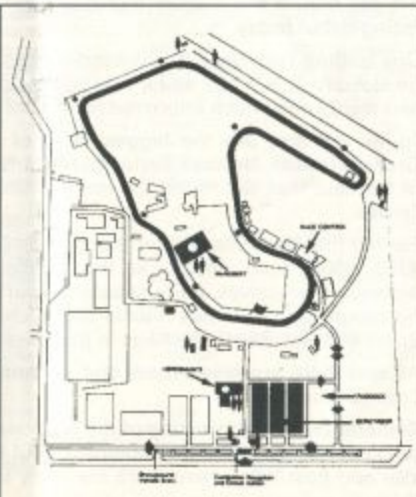

## TODAY'S MEETING

With one more meeting after this one before the end of the 1991 Scottish motor racing season there will be a lot of tension in some of the Scottish Championship Classes to see who will emerge as the Champions of their class. The closest fought class is in the Scottish Road Car Championship where Neil Gammie with his Westfield, David Kerr with his Fiesta and David Finlay with the Nova are all remarkably close and this is a class which could go right down to the wire.

Following the heavy racing day at the last Ingliston meeting in August with the visit of the Formula Vauxhall Lotus competitors there is more space for everyone this time and it also sees a few new faces on the scene. One is Ralph Hutchinson an Englishman living in Saline who has been competing in the Caterham Vauxhall Championship on the southern circuits. His 2 litre Caterham is having to run in the GT class as that Championship runs in more modified rules than the kit car classes here but he is determined to get to know Ingliston and prepare for next season. There is also another addition to the Road Car Classes in Mark Speirs who will be using the trusty Hillman Avenger which has brought a lot of drivers into road car racing such as Glen Mortimer, Lindsay Mann and Bill Aitkenhead. Since buying a Fiesta Bill Aitkenhead has now sold the Avenger to Mark. Then there is the latest of the second generation Ingliston competitors in Lesley Wood the daughter of Bill Wood who will be running Bill's Mallock-Vauxhall for the first time. She tested the car before the August Ingliston race meeting and now will make her racing debut today.

One leading Formula Ford contender missing today is Jim Forsyth who is off on Holiday. It is a pity as he was winner of the Knockhill Formula Ford race two weeks ago which improved his points standing.

Today will also see the biggest field of Citroen 2CV's with leading lights Graham Harper, Norman Taylor and Nick Runcie out to put on the usual show of the cars that sail round the corners like the Santa Maria in the Southern Trades.

For the first time this season there are separate races for the up to 1300 and 1300-1600cc road saloons so the smaller cars will be able to fight it out between themselves. Early season favourite David Finlay has now begun to be caught up by James Ritchie and Richard Dobson's amazing Citroen AX Sport and with Derek Hastings in there we are likely to see quite a battle.

All told there are seven races and we hope they provide the usual Ingliston Entertainment.

Remember the last meeting of the season on October 13 which not only sees the final rounds in the Championship but the two races for historic cars, Pre-War and Post-War where there are likely to be three of the fabulous Cooper-Bristol's racing.

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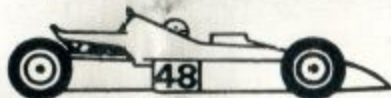
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
