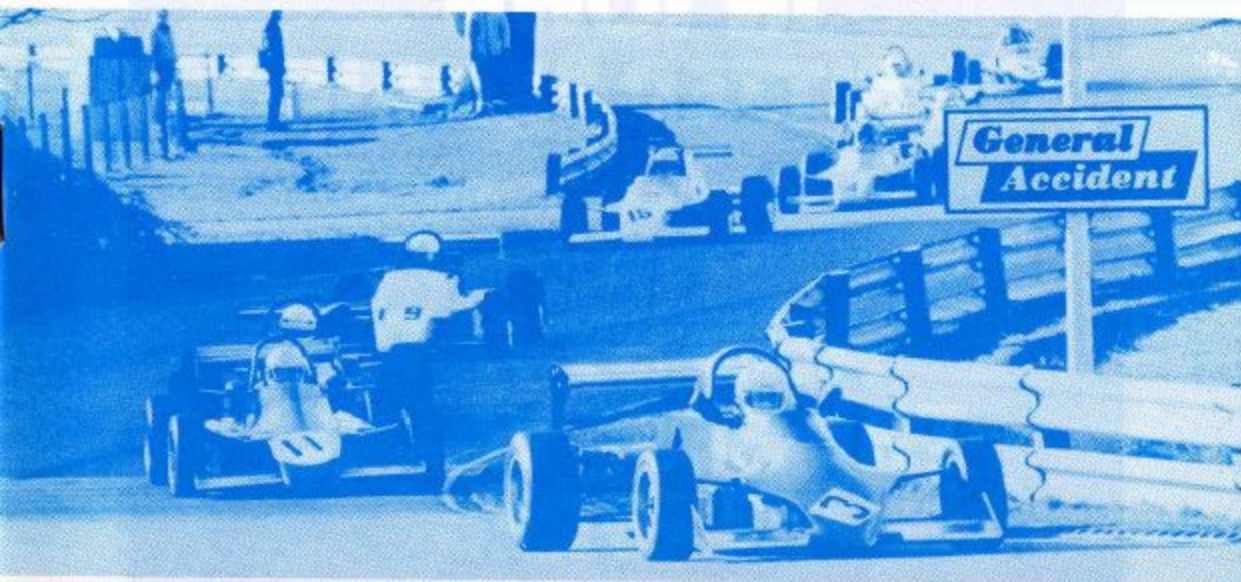

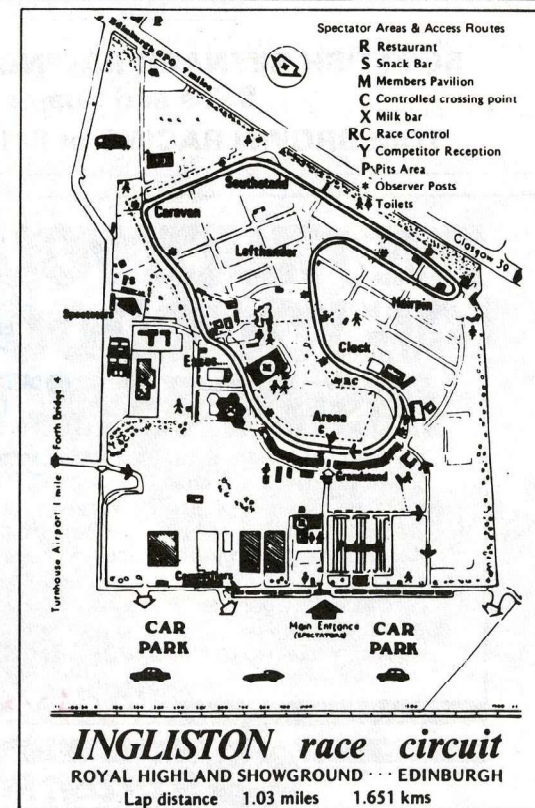

## TODAY'S MEETING

Nineteen years after the last televised race meeting, STV are today basing their Scotsport programme at the circuit with coverage of three races recorded in the afternoon being broadcast from the mobile studio between 5 and 6 p.m. tonight.

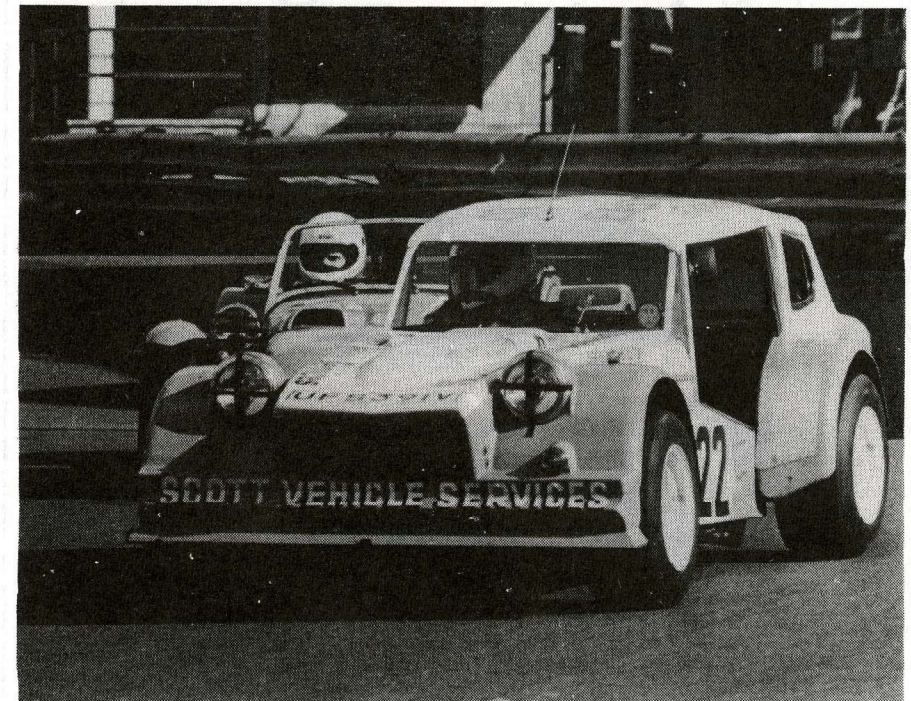

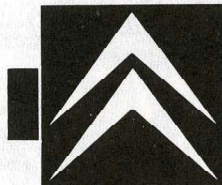
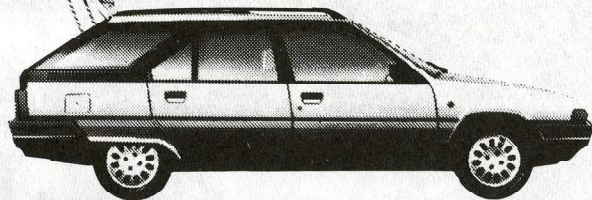

The road sports car race sees our usual faces returning to the fray with a reasonable range of machinery.

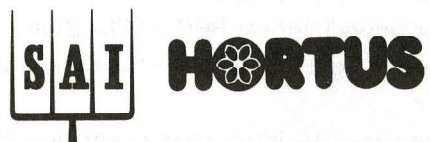

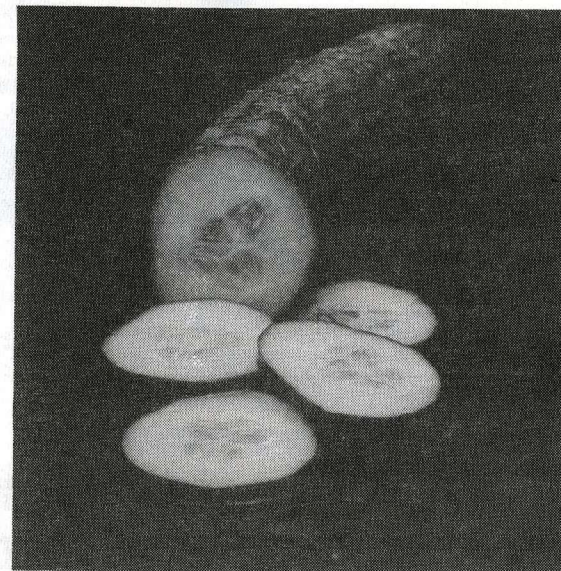

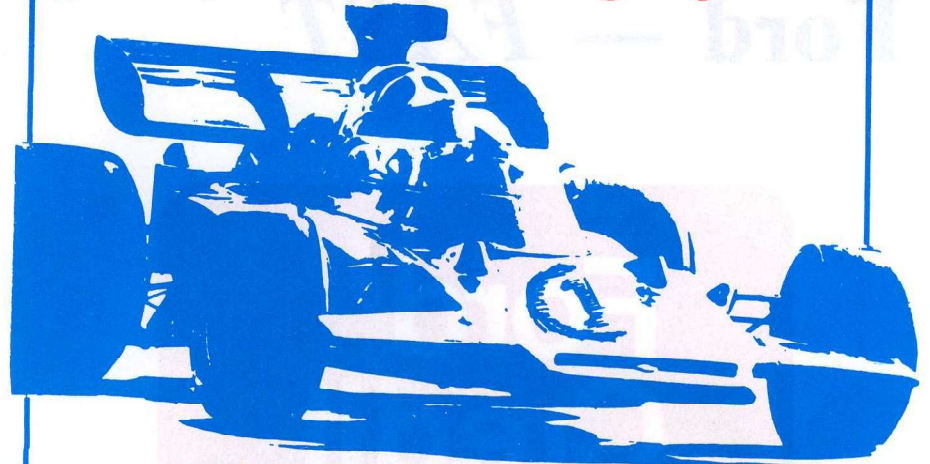
