



There are seven races on the programme for the Scottish Motor Racing Club Ingliston meeting here today though the number of Formula Ford


qualifiers may result in only one FF1600 race being held.

The Modified Road Car and GT Class has attracted a good entry with Russell Paterson's 500 bhp TVR S Turbo more nimble round Ingliston than would be expected. His main opposition will again come from Ron Cumming with the AC ME3000 who at present leads the Sportstune Modified Championship.

There will also be the continued excitement of the road saloons in the Abercromby Championship where Alastair McCarter from Culloden with his 1300 c.c. Mini Cooper still leads from Glen Mortimer's Ford Fiesta. In the over 1600 c.c. class there are two new competitors, Mark Shaw and Norman Insch with their 2-litre Ford Escorts.

In the Kit Car class Angus Gray (Westfield) will be out to defeat regular class winner Neil Gammie (Westfield).

GENERAL FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

As there has been a large entry for the FF1600 class a qualification race of 8 laps will be Race 2; the slowest 20 in practice running in this race. All other drivers qualify automatically for the final, Race 7, where they will be joined by the leading competitors from Race 2 to make a total field of 20. Championship Points will only be scored in the final.

Please note that if only 20 Formula Fords qualify to race after practice, Race 7 will be dropped and Race 2 will become the Formula Ford Championship race and cover 12 laps.

Such a decision will be announced at the Drivers' Briefing.

As the entry for the 1600 c.c. Road Car class is over the maximum 20 starters the fastest 20 qualifiers will run in Event 1; the Championship race. If any other competitors in this class fail to qualify they will race in Event 5 in order to give them an opportunity to compete.

Remember that if you are running a road car you must bring with you a current MoT certificate for the car or else you cannot compete.

Following a meeting with the Scrutineers the following items were agreed and the 1990 Regulations are hereby amended as follows:

- (a) Kit Cars No restriction in capacity and modification of same to apply to Kit Car class; i.e. over-boring of standard block permitted.
- (b) Fire Extinguishers Under Section QG 8.2 regulation QM3 (a)(ii) shall not apply for Road Saloons, Road Sports and Kit Cars — these cars may be fitted with a 1.5 kg minimum hand-operated extinguisher securely fixed to the vehicle.
- (c) Head Restraints Regulation QM13 shall not apply to road going saloons, sports or kit cars.

Competitors wishing to compete in road car classes in vehicles fitted with glass sunroofs should contact Ian Bennie, the Chief Scrutineer, tel. 041-956-3529, who can advise on RAC approved methods of dealing with safety aspects of such installations without removal of glass panel.

With reference to the RAC regulation change all competitors should note that evey race will commence with a Green Flag lap.

Following the guidelines of the RAC regarding attendance by drivers at the Drivers' Briefing you should ensure that you attend the briefing, which is listed in the timetable, and present your card which is attached to your scrutineering label. A fine of £100 or exclusion from the meeting may be levied for non-attendance.







FLAG SIGNALS

Races at Ingliston except the Historic Car event, are now started by Red/Green lights over the circuit. But also signalling to the drivers is by the use of flags round the circuit. The meaning of these signals is as follows:

Blue Flag, stationary - Another competitor is following you close by.

Blue Flag, waved - Another competitor is trying to overtake you.

White Flag - A service car or slow moving car is on the circuit.

Yellow Flag, stationary - Danger, no overtaking and slow down.

Yellow Flag, waved - Great danger, slow down, be prepared to stop. No overtaking.

Yellow Flag with Red Stripes, stationary - Slippery surface ahead.

Yellow Flag with Red Stripes, waved - Slippery surface imminent.

Green Flag — All clear, at the end of a danger area controlled by yellow flags. It can also be used to signal the start of a warm-up lap.

Red Flag — Immediately stop racing and proceed slowly and with maximum caution to pits or start line obeying marshal's instructions, and being prepared to stop should the track be blocked.

Black Flag at individual marshal's posts. The race has been stopped.

Black Flag with Orange Disc displayed with White Number — A warning of apparent mechanical failure or of a fire which might not be obvious to the driver. The car concerned must call at its pit for repairs on the next lap.

Black and White Rectangular Flag split diagonally and displayed with a White Number —
A warning to the driver of the car bearing the number that his behaviour is suspect and that he may be black-flagged on further reports.

Black Flag displayed with White Number — The driver must stop at his pit within one lap of receiving the signal and report to the Clerk of the Course. A penalty of exclusion may be enforced by removing the car from the race by display of the black flag. Black and White Chequered Flag — End of race or finish.
