

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TODAY'S MEETING


Following the STV broadcast from the circuit on 7th September the grids should be as full today as they were on that occasion.





Stewart Roden still having to be placed in the top three today to tie up the title with one meeting to go in 12th October. No doubt Tom Brown the current champion will be trying hard for race honours.

Modified Saloons and Sports Cars run in the last race of the day. Drivers who have not had another race today have priority for grid qualification over drivers who have already run today in the road car classes or GT race. The Davrians may well lead the race but the other well modified cars will be chasing hard and should produce yet another race well worth watching.

The last race meeting of the year is in two weeks on 12th October when all the championships will be finally settled and will include quite a few visiting Irishmen in FF1600 and FF2000, together with our regular Historic Car Race.

For the first time in many years (see Competition) the Lombard RAC Rally visits Ingliston for a spectator special stage on 17th November. The first car is due to start at 7.20 p.m. and the gates will be open at about 5.45 p.m. for a floodlit night stage.
